DISCIPLINE POLICY

We seek to main discipline to create a safe and orderly school environment. Students are expected to be responsible, safe and respectful, whether in the classroom, the hallway, the playground or elsewhere. The intention is to help students develop self - discipline that is needed to become responsible members of the local community, develop respect for themselves and others and to develop sense of acceptance of the consequences of their behaviour. Disciplinary action is taken for misdemeanors and is treated in a positive manner. Parents are made aware of the disciplinary issues as the need arises, and , if necessary, parents are requested to be a part of the corrective action. Misdemeanors broadly categorised into two types and accordingly students are reminded that this is only a general categorization and any disciplinary action taken against a misdemeanors will be based on its consequences and the individual case in hand and not just by following the guidelines below:

Minor Misdemeanors include, but are not restricted to the following:

- * Tardiness school, classroom and assembly. *Disturbing the class while it is session.
- * Tampering with lights or AC switches.
- * Writing on desktops or school walls.
- * Use of inappropriate language.
- * Non - completion of homework.
- * Chewing gum on the premises.
- * Not wearing full uniform including ID card.
- * Misbehaviour at assembly.
- * Absence without intimation.
- * Possession of electronic equipment.

Major Misdemeanors include, but are not restricted to the guidelines below:

- * Bullying of any kind
- * Dishonesty, cheating, Plagiarism, knowingly furnishing false information
- * Theft or, damage to, or destruction of any school property or others while on the school campus.

- * Disobedience and confrontational behaviour *Fighting and causing physical injury to another student at school
- * Use of profanity or abusive, vulgar language *Recording the voice or image of another student or staff member
- * Public display of affection
- * Vandalism - littering,destruction of property, defacing school property
- * Violating of safety rules
- * Possession of tobacco or cigarettes
- * Intimidating staff members or students
- * Possession of obscene material
- * Possession of knives,lighter,etc.
- * Misuse of school computer or internet

Disciplinary Action: Generally, consequences and corrective measures will include, but will not be limited to the following:

- * Case recorded/ parents to be informed
- * Letter of warning/ meeting with parents
- * Detention during or after school hours
- * One day suspension
- * Three day suspension
- * Expulsion.
